All solid waste, recycling facilities remain open on Kaua'i

County Officials are notifying the public that all solid waste and recycling facilities are fully operational at this time.

Operating hours for the Refuse transfer stations are 7:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. seven days a week. Kekaha Landfill is open from 8a.m. to 4 p.m. with lunch from noon to 12:30 p.m. daily. Green waste recycling at all refuse transfer stations are operating normally, but availability is weather dependent. Please see updates at the County website at:

All Kaua'i Recycling drop bins are open. HI5 Redemption Centers are operating on the normal schedules. Please see the website for days and times of operation at:
