### **Mayor signs 13<sup>th</sup> supplementary emergency proclamation for COVID-19**

LĪHU'E – Mayor Derek S. K. Kawakami on Monday signed the 13th supplementary emergency proclamation on COVID-19 for the County of Kaua'i, in order to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Kaua'i.

The Mayor's 13<sup>th</sup> supplementary emergency proclamation authorizes the County of Kaua'i to take immediate action to mitigate the potential impacts of COVID-19. It allows the County to be proactive in establishing a plan for officials to mobilize resources if and when needed.

The disaster emergency relief period shall continue until terminated 60 days after Feb. 7, 2022, or by a separate proclamation – whichever comes first.
