

KAUA'I POLICE DEPARTMENT
 SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION FOR LICENSE TO CARRY FIREARM
 CONCEALED/UNCONCEALED

In accordance with the Kaua'i Police Department requirements to obtain a License to Carry a Firearm (Concealed/Unconcealed), applicants must submit a copy of a signed firearms proficiency test including scores administered by a State-Certified or National Rifle Association Firearms Instructors.

The State-Certified or National Rifle Association Firearm Instructors are responsible for determining the course of fire to be performed by the applicant that will allow the Instructor to certify that the applicant is proficient in the handling and use of the firearm involved. At the minimum, the proficiency course of fire conducted by Firearm Instructors should consist of the following, with a passing score of 75% or greater.
