Guidance Bulletin #6 - Enforcement of Mayor's Emergency Rule #5

**Delivery of Ordered Hardware Supplies** 

Governor's Third Supplementary Proclamation Paragraphs I.C & I.D

Mayor's Emergency Rule #5, Local Rules II.9 & II.10

May I request your officers and inspectors exercise discretion regarding the delivery of construction materials related to the above referenced local rules.

We have been alerted that many orders for construction materials, placed weeks if not months ago, are only arriving in shipments now. If these materials are not moved through the supply logistics chain, backlogs can occur at either the Port of Honolulu or Nāwiliwili.

Given the need to preserve the integrity of our shipping supply chains, establishments classified under Local Rule II.9 should be allowed to deliver ordered materials to a site or address regardless if it is an essential activity. However, the delivery of these materials is not permission to initiate construction, or have construction deemed essential given Local Rule II.10.

Should a violator under Local Rule II.10 claim a Hardware Store represented deliveries provide for construction to proceed, please contact the EOC to have county staff initiate corrective communications.

Further, delivery individuals should safely minimize crews, and avoid riding in the same delivery vehicle as much as possible – with a recommended instruction to wear cloth masks.
