  - d. Best Management Practices to be used to control dust emissions, sedimentation, and erosion to the maximum extent practicable by watering with trucks or sprinklers, erection of dust and silt fences, limiting the area of disturbance, and timely grassing of disturbed bare areas.
  - e. Statement indicating the disposition of grubbed materials.
