The Design Workshop is intended to engage community members in envisioning how East Kaua'i will change and grow over time, while considering factors such as community character, multimodal transportation, connectivity, and community resilience. What is...?

Walking / Bus Tour

Site visits open to the public led by the design team, these give participants the tools and knowledge to explore, understand, and document ideas for their communities.

Open Studio

Informal working sessions open to the public. Stop by to see what the design team is producing, ask questions and share ideas.

Open House

Mid-week presentations open to the public. The design team will share their in-progress work and explain design concepts to get feedback.

Opening + Closing Presentations

Presentations by the design team at the start and end of the design workshop to communicate the design intent and focus, and summarize the work done. These are a great opportunity for community members to understand design opportunities and challenges, ask questions, share their thoughts and provide feedback.
