# **General Information**

(Drivers have the authority to enforce policies)

#### ROUTES

Although drivers follow a predetermined schedule, arrival at bus stops may be affected due to traffic, operating conditions and route deviations.

Pick up and/or drop off at undesignated locations are not allowed.

#### VEHICLES

Each vehicle has a destination sign on the front and route number curbside of the vehicle.

All vehicles are lift equipped to accommodate persons with mobility aids and others who are not able to use stairs.

Able to accommodate common wheelchair. (53" L, 33" W, 800 lbs. when occupied)

Air conditioned for your comfort.

Equipped with bike racks.

## RIDING TIPS

Make sure you are on the correct route before dropping your fare.

Have fare/pass/proper ID for reduced fare ready before boarding. NO change available. NO refund once fare deposited.

Be alert at all times for sudden stops.

Sit when possible. Don't change seats after the bus starts moving. If you must change seats do so only when bus is stopped.

Keep windows closed for safety reasons and for air conditioning comfort.
